Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) Home Subscriber Server (HSS) is responsible for keeping a master list of features and services associated with each IMS and EPS subscriber. It also provides subscriber profile information, supports user authentication and authorization, and provides location information on the subscriber, naming or addressing resolution, and access profiles supporting the network entities that handle connections. This course covers the delta features and functions between two HSS releases—as requested by you.
