DEFINITIONS

Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this ALA document are defined in the governing agreement.

Term	Definition
Unique Device	means an addressable entity, physical or virtual, including but not limited to router, switch, bridge, hub, server, PC, laptops, mobile device, handheld device, or printer that resides within the range defined for interrogation and asset tracking.
E-LTU and E-Media	means products which are electronically delivered only, and as such any reference to FOB Destination or delivery methods that are stated on your purchase order other than electronic shall be null and void with respect to these E-LTU or E-Media products.
LTU	means License To Use.
Transaction	One transaction corresponds to one message received into the platform from the network, that trigger a service to process and send back one message to the network (1 transaction = two messages, typically request-response).
TPS	Transactions Per Second.
Use	means to install, store, load, execute, and display one copy of the software.

SOFTWARE SPECIFIC LICENSE TERMS

Software products with software specific license terms are described below.

HPE Real Time Charging (HPE RTC)

The HPE RTC software is licensed (perpetual license) based on:

- Basic tier:
 - Platform: licenses required for new HPE RTC customers only.
 - Capacity: there are two capacity license models that can be select by customer:
 - Total number of Transaction Per Second (TPS) in HPE RTC external network interfaces (total number of TPS is determined based on a three month audit period), or
 - Total number of Unique Devices connecting to the software (total number of devices is determined based on a three month audit period)

- Advanced tier: Advanced features license is required to use an optional licensed feature (such as Account Balance Manager, Offline Charting, Rerating, PCC Enabler).

The HPE RTC software requires a separate license to a third-party database and a separate license to an in memory database to operate. These licenses are available through HPE.

The HPE RTC Consumption offering:

- This offering gives the right to use the HPE RTC software during a limited period, with a minimal term, to be renewed or extended if needed. There will be a pre-determined minimum number of unique devices per month that will be charged, and invoicing will occur quarterly in arrears based on actual usage.

Interfering or disabling any software designed to allow HPE to monitor consumption will be a material breach of this license. After termination of the consumption contract, the customer has no further rights to use the RTC software.

ADDITIONAL LICENSE TERMS

Term

- A.** Software may contain open source and/or third-party software and associated specifications that are confidential to, and trade secrets of, such parties. You will not take any action other than to Use it as authorized under the agreement as part of the software products and will not disclose it to third parties.
